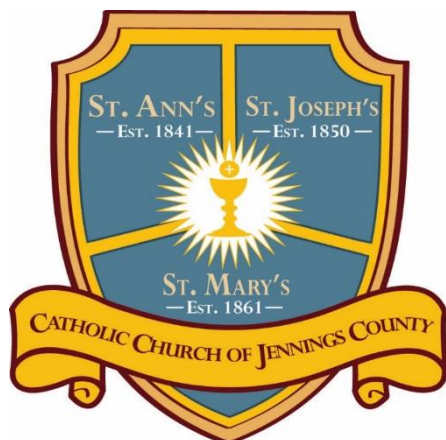

Triduum Services

Over the past few years, we have celebrated multiple Triduum services here in Jennings County. This year, we will celebrate one Triduum at St. Mary's, that will be for all three parishes. We will not have multiple Masses on Holy Thursday or multiple services on Good Friday. There will be an opportunity for prayers at the Tomb of the Savior at St. Joseph and St. Ann churches the evening of Good Friday. The primary reason for this change is that the Triduum liturgy is a continual liturgy, and splitting up the parts of the Triduum between parishes disrupts the continuity of the celebration. It is the desire of the Church in situations where multiple parishes share a pastor, that the Triduum is celebrated in one place for all. I have decided that we will celebrate one Triduum for all three parishes. I realize that this will be a change from what we are accustomed to, but I believe it to be the best option for our communities. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
