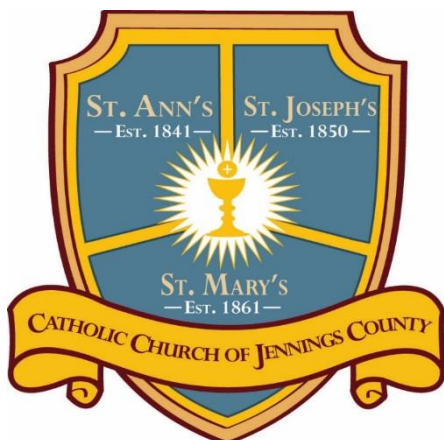

St. Vincent dePaul – how your donation works

Pope Francis has been vocal regarding our need to "show mercy to our common home", as it pertains to the environment. North Vernon SVDP works towards this endeavor as it accepts donations from the many generous members of our community and provides assistance to those in need.

- A. Items (clothing/bedding/household items) donated to SVDP NV store are sorted and processed by volunteers and identified for:
 1. Sale in the local thrift store, **or**
 2. Sale at discount as "rags" (select cotton items to local businesses, **or**
 3. Placement in bins for shipment to SVDP Indianapolis for their outreach endeavors.
- B. Items deemed saleable are priced at discount and placed in the NV thrift store for sale to the public. Proceeds are used for services to those in need.
- C. Items that do not sale after being in the local store for five weeks are processed by volunteers and:
 1. Identified for deep discount (75¢) and left for an additional week, **or**
 2. Delivered to Jennings County re-cycle program at the fairgrounds location, **or**
 3. Placed in bins for shipment to SVDP Indianapolis for their outreach endeavors.
- D. The Indianapolis SVDP delivers a truck to NV upon request to pick up surplus items not sold in the local store (local K of C members assist with loading the truck), and:
 1. Processes items for sale in their thrift store, **or**
 2. In the case of coats, provides to the poor via a Special Works program, **or**
 3. Prepares items for bulk bailing for:
 - a. Shipment to 3rd world countries for use as clothing as deemed appropriate, **or**
 - b. Shipment to processors for use in industrial applications (ex. Insulation). Income from such shipments is returned to Indianapolis SVDP for use in their outreach programs

The SVDP Board and volunteers continue to be grateful for the support received from both the local Catholic parishes and the greater Jennings County community.

ARE YOU A REGISTER MEMBER OF ST. ANN'S, ST. JOSEPH'S OR ST. MARY'S?

You would be surprised how many people believe they are registered members, but actually are not. Here is some information about being a registered member:

- *If you are currently receiving collection envelopes every two months through the mail, you are registered in one of the parishes.*
- *If you are not receiving these envelopes, then you are **NOT** registered in any of the parishes.*
- *If you are 18 years or older and in the work force, **you should be registered on your own in the parish of your choice not under your parents.***

Be aware that if you are not registered, and want to rent any of the facilities, enroll your children in the school, get married in the churches, have children baptized, buy burial plots, etc. fees and requirements may be different than those who are registered members.
