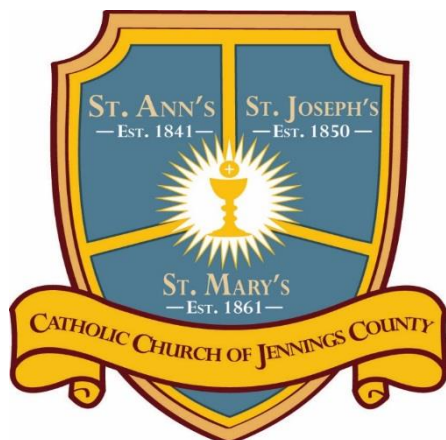

● **Great News!** St. Mary's School received a Growth and Expansion Grant from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis in fall for \$20,000. A portion of the money was used to replace the fire system panel and the smoke detectors throughout the school. The remainder of the money will be used to update the panel for the heating and cooling system. We also just received word that we were approved for another \$16,000 in the spring. We will be using this money to update some of our technology and to help convert the old computer lab into a classroom. The Growth and Expansion Endowment Fund provides support to archdiocesan parishes, schools, and agencies that are growing or expanding their ministries.

ARE YOU A REGISTER MEMBER OF ST. ANN'S, ST. JOSEPH'S OR ST. MARY'S?

You would be surprised how many people believe they are registered members, but actually are not. Here is some information about being a registered member:

● ***If you are currently receiving collection envelopes every two months through the mail, you are registered in one of the parishes.***

● ***If you are not receiving these envelopes, then you are NOT actively registered in any of the parishes.***

● ***If you are 18 years or older and in the work force, you should be registered on your own in the parish of your choice not under your parents.***

Be aware that if you are not registered, and want to rent any of the facilities, enroll your children in the school, get married in the churches, have children baptized, buy burial plots, etc. fees and requirements may be different than those who are actively registered members.
