# <u>St. Mary's Catholic School</u>

Did you know that St. Mary's School offers several extra-curricular activities that appeal to a wide variety of interests? St. Mary's School offers several different athletic opportunities for young people. Students in grades 5 and 6 can participate in a competitive basketball program. We also offer volleyball to girls in grades 5 and 6. St. Mary's School has an archery team with students in grades 4-8 competing at the state, national, and world level; students in grade 3 have the opportunity to be a part of the team and compete in open tournaments.

St. Mary's School also has academic extracurricular activities. We have a Math Bowl team; students in grades 4-6 compete at a local and state level. St. Mary's School works in conjunction with the Jennings County Public Library to host a book club once a month. We also have a robotics team, and students build their own robot to take to competitions.

St. Mary's School has a wonderful music program. Students in grade 4 are introduced to a musical instrument and learning to read music with the recorder. We offer band to students in grades 5-8. Students also have the opportunity to participate in the ISSMA solo/ensemble vocal and instrument competition. Our seventh and eighth graders also learn to cantor at Mass and can sing in the school choir.
