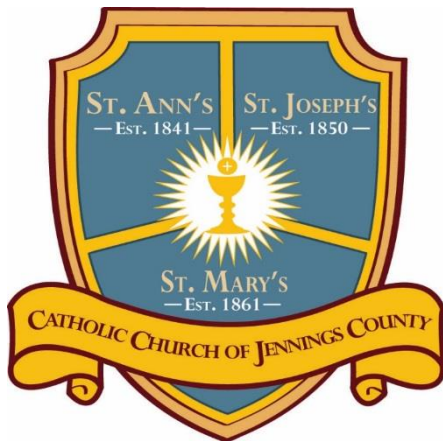

**Presentation at Jennings Public Library – January 20<sup>th</sup>**

Walter (Wally) Glover, the retired chaplain for St. Vincent Jennings Hospital, will give a presentation on his mountain climbs at 2 p.m. Saturday, Jan 20 at the Jennings Public Library. Walter has written two books about his climbs of Mount Everest and Mount Kilimanjaro, and mountains in Russia and Australia. He has a master's degree in theology from St. Meinrad School of Theology. His climbs have included five of the Seven Summits and the trek pilgrimage across Spain known as El Camino, the Way of St. James. The expeditions raised more than \$100,000- to support St. Vincent Hospital youth obesity weight management clinics including at St. Vincent Jennings. His books will be available for sale at discounted prices.
