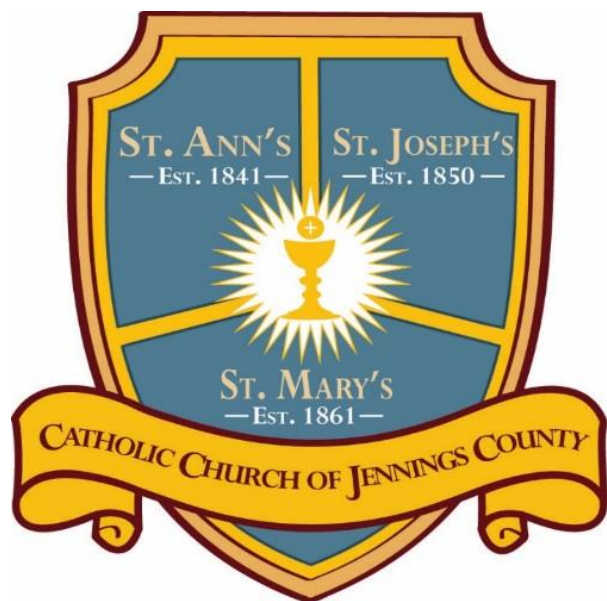


# Catholic Church of Jennings County
