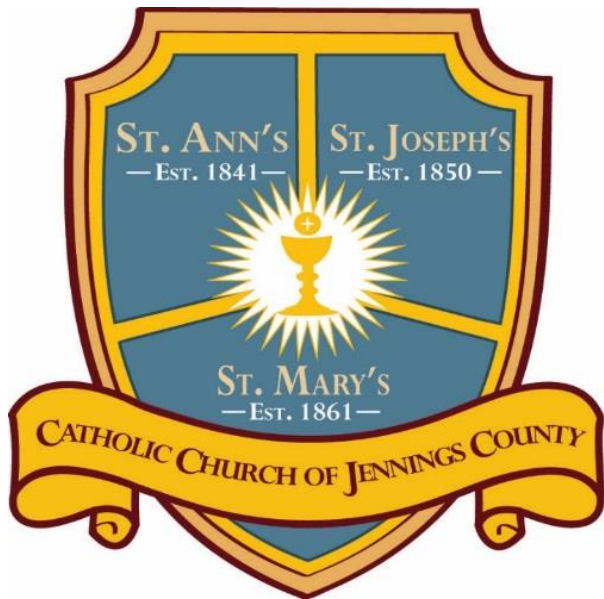


# Catholic Church of Jennings County

- 3) If you have a check for another parish that is not your regular parish, please **DO NOT** put it in your Sunday Collection envelope - put it in another envelope or turn it in by itself.
- 4) Anything put in the extra collections envelopes (these are the ones that are white trimmed in blue or green or yellow) go to extra collections most likely to the archdiocese and this money **WILL** be sent off
