

WELCOME RETREAT

April 27-28, 2019 – St. Mary's Parish Center

Matthew Kelly with Dynamic Catholic absorbed the Christ Renews His Parish (CRHP) program. They updated the materials for the program and renamed the updated version "Welcome." The Welcome retreat is open to all adult women and stresses a clear focus on the Gospel, the Good News of Jesus Christ. It emphasizes continued growth in Christian life in our daily contacts with others. The weekend offers an excellent opportunity to meet other people in our parish. LITURGICAL QUESTION BOX

Q: When I go to other parishes for Mass, I notice that they do not use incense, but we use incense every Sunday. What is its purpose, and what is it made out of?

A: Incense has been used in the worship of God for millennia. It is the resin from certain trees that is burned on charcoal to produce a sweet fragrance. In the Old Testament (Exodus 30:1-10) God commands that Aaron burn incense upon the Altar in the Sanctuary. Due to its pleasing odor, incense is seen as a pleasing offering to God. The smoke of the incense serves as a visual reminder to us as of our prayers rising to God. One of the gifts brought to the infant Jesus by the Magi was that of Frankincense - a gift befitting a God. Christians in the early Church recognized that the celebration of the Mass was a sharing in the liturgy of heaven, and included the use of incense in the celebration of the Sacred Mysteries - as a sweet and fragrant offering to God the Father. We continue the practice of using incense in our worship. Its sweet aroma symbolizes something pleasing and acceptable being offered to God. Burning incense is also a sign of reverence and dedication. At funerals, we incense the deceased's body in recognition of it being the temple of God. We use incense at the Altar because it represents Christ and His sacrifice. We incense the gifts offered on the altar, which become His Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity. We incense the book of the Gospels, because it is God's word. We incense the Blessed Sacrament, because it is Our Lord's true presence. We incense the Easter Candle, because it represents Christ as the light of the world. We incense the priest because he stands in Persona Christi Capitis (in the person of Christ the head). We incense the people at Mass because they are the Body of Christ. Hopefully this sweet aroma will enhance our worship and remind us of the sweet offering God made to us of His son Jesus and will remind us to make our sacrifice of praise to God in our worship!
