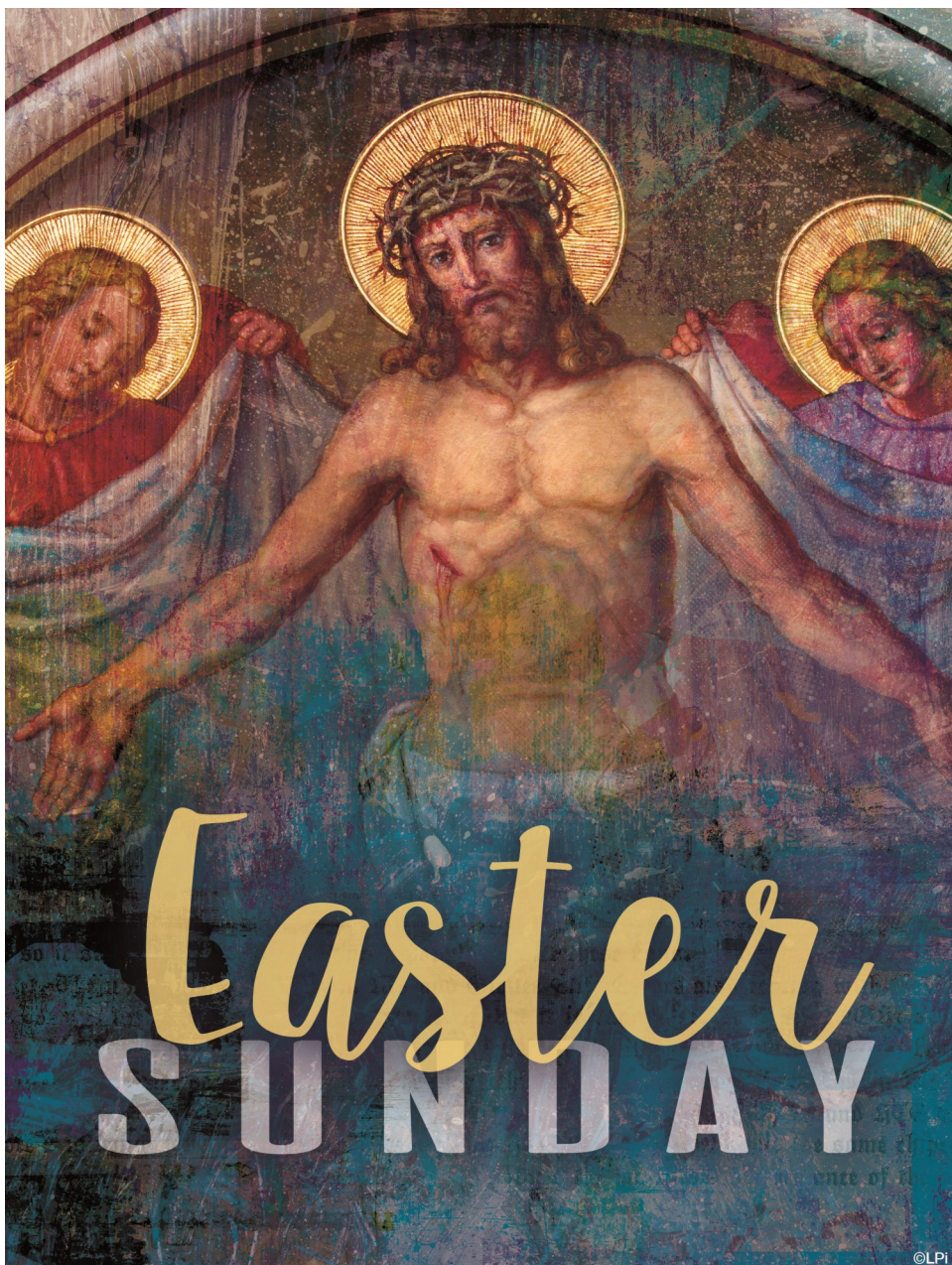

## PARISH NEWS

### LITURGICAL QUESTION BOX

#### Q. What is the purpose of the Sprinkling Rite?

**A.** The sprinkling rite is an option that is used in some places for the penitential rite of the Mass. At the Easter Vigil, and Easter Sunday Mass, the sprinkling rite is called for by the rubrics of the Mass, and is done after the congregation has renewed their baptismal promises. The water used can be blessed at the Mass by the priest or water that has already been blessed may be used.

This purpose of this rite is to remind us of our baptism. In the days prior to the Second Vatican Council, this rite happened every Sunday right before Mass began, and was accompanied by the chanting of the *Asperges Me, Domine* during the year, and the *Vidi Aquam* during Eastertide.

The priest will use an *Aspergillum* to sprinkle the holy water that is carried in a special bucket called the *Aspersorium*. When we feel the drops of holy water fall on us, we should bless ourselves, just like we do at the fonts when we enter or exit the church. To be reminded of our baptism is to be reminded that we have been claimed by Christ, that we have died with him, and have risen to new life with him!
