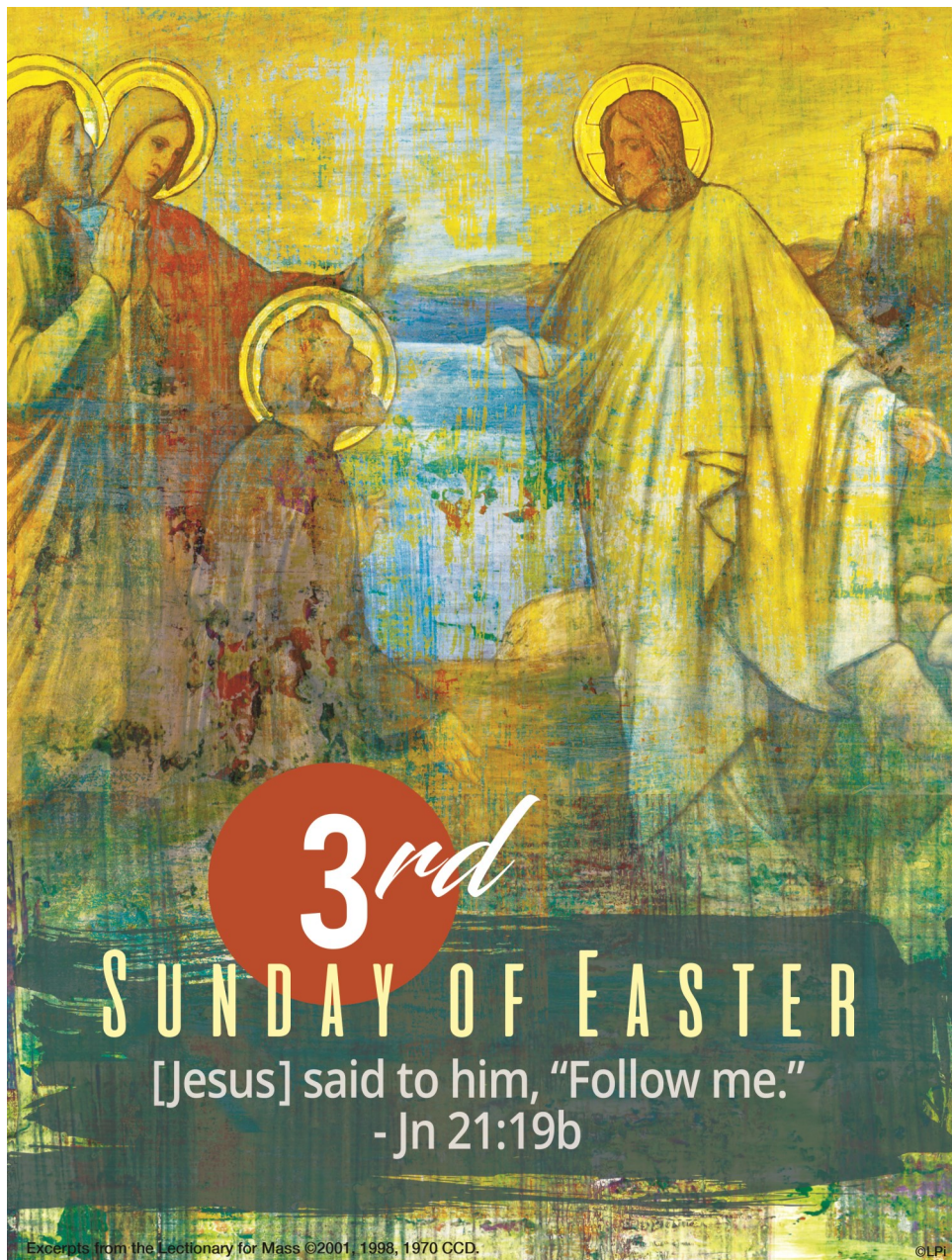

PARISH NEWS

CHURCH ENVELOPE ETIQUETTE

Please be attentive to these items concerning your church envelope that you put in the Sunday Collection.

- 1) **PLEASE DO NOT** put tape or stickers on the back of the envelope—this makes it more difficult for the counter and for those who post your collections.
- 2) **REMEMBER** that anything out in the regular envelopes (green–St. Mary's | blue– St. Joseph's | yellow– St. Ann's) **WILL** be posted to **SUNDAY COLLECTION REGARDLESS OF WHAT IS WRITTEN ON THE ENVELOPE.**
- 3) If you have a check for another parish that is not your regular parish, please **DO NOT** put it in your Sunday Collection envelope—please put it in another envelope or turn it in by itself.
- 4) Anything put in the extra collection envelopes (these are the white envelopes that are either trimmed in green, blue or yellow) go to extra collections most likely at the Archdiocese and this money **WILL** be sent off.
- 5) If you could use your church envelope versus a loose check for your Sunday Collection that would be very helpful for posting purposes. We understand that this just may not be possible all the time.
- 6) If you put money in the children's envelopes, this **WILL NOT** be posted to an individual's contribution record—funds sent in children's collections will be put into a fund for seminarians.
