

PARISH NEWS

Q. What is the best place for a Eulogy?

A. For a while, if you went to a Catholic funeral, chances were good that you would hear a eulogy about the deceased during the Mass. Unbeknownst to most people, even some clergy, a eulogy is expressly forbidden during the funeral Mass. The Order of Christian Funerals mentions eulogies only one time in the general instruction (the instructions on who to celebrate the liturgies). It says in paragraph 27: "A brief homily based on the readings is always given after the gospel reading at the funeral liturgy and may also be given after the readings at the vigil service; but there is never to be a eulogy..." This is why we do not have eulogies as part of the Mass (immediately prior to, during, or after in the Church) in the parishes in Jennings County. So, then, where could a eulogy be done in conjunction with the funeral liturgy? There are three options: 1. At the end of the Vigil for the Deceased prior to the funeral Mass. This usually happens the night before at the funeral home. Many people chose this option because it is when most people are present to pay their respects, and is an opportune time to share stories of the deceased. 2. Following the burial rites at the cemetery. 3. During the meal shared with family and friends following the burial rites.
