LITURGICAL QUESTION BOX

Q. Who can be chosen as godparent or sponsor for baptism and confirmation?

A. According to the Code of Canon Law, a person may only have one or two godparents (also called sponsors); if two are chosen, they must be male and female.

In order for someone to be eligible as a godparent or sponsor they have to meet the following criteria:

1. They must be chosen by the parents.
2. They have the ability and the intention to fulfill the role of godparent/sponsor.
3. They must be at least 16 years of age.
4. They must have received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
5. They must have received the Most Holy Eucharist.
6. They must be a Catholic in good standing with the Church—which means they attend Sunday and Holy day Mass, receive the Sacraments frequently and faithfully, and if married, they are married in the Church.
7. They will be a good role model for the one being baptized.
8. They may not be the father nor the mother of the child.

A baptized person who belongs to another Christian community may be admitted only as a “Christian witness” (not a godparent) provided that there is at least one Roman Catholic godparent who fulfills the above criteria. A non-baptized person cannot be a witness (Code of Canon Law, cc. 872-874; Catechism of the Catholic Church 1255).
