Bobby's favorite saint is San Jose Sanchez del Rio. His story of martyrdom is heroic. He died at the age of 14 fighting for his faith. It helped to understand the beauty of relationships and how it leads people to God. His work on goodness helped me to understand my own vocation in a new profound light.
