The purpose of the Facilities Committee is to evaluate church property, including the cemetery, and make recommendations regarding upkeep and improvements necessary to ensure future service. The paving of the parking, access area around the rectory and Emergency Management building was completed in fall of 2020. Additionally the driveway into the cemetery was paved with the addition of a canopy pad next to the cemetery for graveside services.
