DID YOU KNOW?

The beginning of February falls during the liturgical season known as *Tempus per Annum* or **Ordinary Time** (formerly *Time After Epiphany*), which is represented by the liturgical color green. Green is a symbol of hope, as it is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection. The remaining days of February (Ash Wednesday is Feb. 22) begins **Lent**. The liturgical color changes to purple — a symbol of penance, mortification and the sorrow of a contrite heart.
