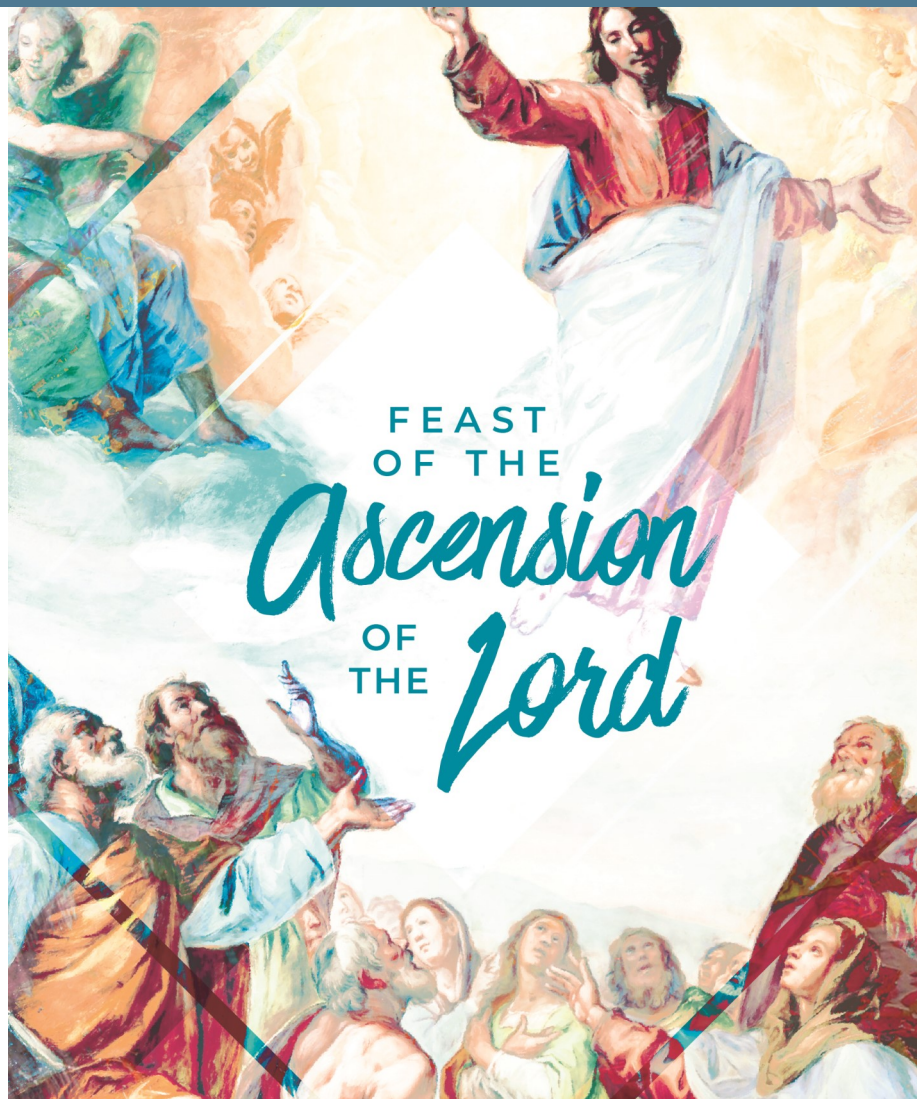

ADULT CONFIRMATION

BAPTIZED CATHOLIC ADULTS ARE

eligible for the Sacrament of Confirmation on Sunday, June 4 at 2 p.m. at SS. Peter and Paul Cathedral in Indianapolis.

Archbishop Charles Thompson extends an invitation to any baptized Catholic adult who has not received the Sacrament of Confirmation under the following conditions:

- Those to be confirmed are baptized Catholics
- It is preferred they are 18 years old
- They should be in a state of grace and are suitably instructed.

In general, the candidates for June 4 are from two groups.

1. Those who are active, practicing, and catechized members of the parish community who have missed the Sacrament of Confirmation due to moves from one parish to another. Or as teenagers felt they were not 'ready' for the sacrament or those who just fell through the cracks of missing the preparation.
2. The others may be practicing Catholics who will need some catechesis, such as a refresher course that can be done easily by speaking to the priest or help from their confirmation sponsor. Please call the parish office for more information at: 812.346.3604. **The deadline to apply is May 25!**
