

SACRED HEART OF JESUS

In 1856, Pope Pius IX established the Feast of the Sacred Heart. We celebrate it June 16 and the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary on June 17.

A devotion to the Sacred Heart is one of gratitude for Christ's love of us. A devotion to the IHM indicates a desire to emulate Mary's love of Christ. Christ appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1672 asking to be honored in Eucharistic adoration during a Holy Hour on Thursdays, a feast day devoted to His Sacred Heart & encouraged the faithful to receive communion on the First Friday of every month.
