ST. MARY MAGDALENE FEAST DAY JULY 22

Saint Spotlight

The feast of St. Mary Magdalene is one of the sweetest and strongest because her love was so great. Her great love was praised by Christ in the Gospel. She is the first recorded witness to the Resurrection of Christ as He appeared to her on Easter morning. A tradition of the 13th century states that after the martyrdom of St James the Greater in Jerusalem many Christians were evicted from the city and placed upon a boat without a sail or a rudder. Miraculously this group, which included Mary Magdalene, Lazarus, and Martha, reached the southern shores of France. She gave herself to a life of prayer and spent thirty years as a hermit in a cave above the present-day village of Plan-d'Aups-Sainte-Baume. A competing theory is that Mary Magdalene was buried in Ephesus close to the house of the Blessed Virgin Mary. From here her relics were transferred to Constantinople and then to Western Europe.

"The Lord Jesus on the night he was betrayed" (1 Cor 11:23) instituted the Eucharistic Sacrifice of his body and his blood. The words of the Apostle Paul bring us back to the dramatic setting in which the Eucharist was born. The Eucharist is indelibly marked by the event of the Lord's passion and death, of which it is not only a reminder but the sacramental re-presentation. It is the sacrifice of the Cross perpetuated down the ages. This truth is well expressed by the words with which the assembly in the Latin rite responds to the priest's proclamation of the "Mystery of Faith": *"We announce your death, O Lord."* (ECCLESIA DE EUCHARISTIA)
