

"I do therefore invite my fellow citizens in every part of the United States, and also those who are at sea and those who are sojourning in foreign lands, to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November, as a day of Thanksgiving and Praise to to our beneficent Father who dwelleth in the Heavens." (Proclamation, Oct. 3, 1963.)

This American holiday closely resembles the symbolism and meaning of the Eucharist. Eucharist itself means Thanksgiving. We celebrate Thanksgiving as a sign of American unity and thanksgiving to God who has given us great gifts. (*Excerpted from the Religion Teacher*)
