

Fr. Byrd heard 436 confessions during Lent. We've had nine babies baptized, three weddings, and one Catholic school student enter the Church all this Easter season. We had about 30 altar servers combined in total at four Easter Masses and Holy Week services. Our five seminarians served most of those. Deacon Bobby Vogel from our parish will be ordained on June 1. We had 34 people travel on our Lenten Pilgrimage to the Blessed Sacrament Shrine in Alabama. Our SVDP Society was overwhelmed with generosity from our parishioners for their annual Lenten Food Drive.
