GRANT AWARD TO ST. MARY

WE ARE HAPPY TO ANNOUNCE WE RECEIVED A \$32,500 GRANT FOR A NEW ORGAN FROM THE JAMES P. SCOTT ENDOWMENT FUND FROM THE CATHOLIC COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF INDIANAPOLIS. Fr. Byrd calls it our Catholic organ because it was the organ at the National Eucharistic Congress and has a full 150 stops that's a lot of musical ability for our beautiful church!

The cost of the organ is \$65,000 with a 10 year warranty that will last us much longer! Our old organ at St. Mary is small, it was meant for funeral homes and ordered from the Sears catalog. It also has cloth wiring! We have to match our grant so envelopes will be in the pews for donations! The generosity of this grant is a blessing. More than \$815,000 was awarded across our archdiocese!


